The **NCEM Land Search Field Team Member** (FTM) Standard provides State-level credentialing of first responders to a national standard and meets the requirements for knowledge, skills, and abilities set forth in ASTM F2209 and NIMS Wilderness Search Technician to understand the principles of search and rescue, navigate accurately on land, and survive an unexpected wilderness emergency. **The Technical Rescuer TR Wilderness block** will present the Rescuer with the knowledge, skills, and abilities to satisfy the requirements of Chapter 16 – Wilderness of NFPA 1006: Standard for Technical Rescuer Professional Qualifications.

These courses are comprised of both classroom and field-based instruction and will cover objectives such as: SAR Operations, Legal, Personal Equipment, Wilderness Survival, Land Navigation, Search Skills, Rope Rescue and Aircraft. The 24 hr. Pack List/contents are one of the KSA's to be checked as part of NCEM credentialing and all items must be present during the "Pack Check".

Each certification, LSFTM & TR Wilderness, require an individual 100 question written exam. If you are seeking both certifications, you will take two 100 question exams.

All portions of the program must be completed to gain certification and credentialing.
