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**Module 21: Flood Scenario Tabletop Activity**

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**Learning Outcomes Checklist**

1. Outcomes will be successfully accomplished when the following is completed for each message inject from 1-36.
2. The order of completing each task does not need to follow the list alphabetically. This list of items is not all-inclusive of every task that may be accomplished; however, seventy-five percent of the below tasks are a minimum that should be accomplished for evaluation purposes
3. In this design, there is a SITSTAT board and SITSTAT map(s), these may be paper, electronic or large laminated sheets.
4. The role players will also need blank ICS 213 General Message forms.
5. This scenario is designed to portray multiple days, and shall be coordinated as such.
6. Instructors may decide that this EOC staffing is the 12 hour day shift for simulation purposes and reality, as the events play out over “multiple days.”
7. EOC Manager shall conduct a briefing every 45-60 minutes or more often as necessary.

**Message # 1:**

Please take a few minutes to organize your EOC and report the following to your facilitator:

- Describe the EOC organizational structure using a wall chart.
- Describe how you will manage the flow of messages into, out of, and within the EOC. Your plan for internal EOC communications should address the following:
  - How will you decide what information to share?
  - Who will share information with whom, when, and how?
  - How often will briefings be conducted and by whom?
  - What information will be documented and how will the documentation occur?
  - What information will be included in the Common Operating Plan?
  - When will situation reports be released?
- Who the media spokesperson will be and what the media release procedures will be.
- How will your EOC manage the decision making process?
- Determine how you will provide situational awareness

Ask the facilitator if there are any questions concerning the EOC organization.

## Module 21: Learning Outcomes Checklist

### Message # 2:

Rising water on the Roaring River is within 1,000 yards of the water intake point at the water treatment plant. Crews are working on sandbagging the plant and at this time are able to keep the floodwaters away from the intake point.

Crews also report that the electric power station at R and 20<sup>th</sup> St is in danger of becoming inundated with floodwaters. Three schools located on the east side of the river, south of 20<sup>th</sup> St are also very close to being affected by the rising waters. DPW crews are fully engaged in sandbagging operations but are in need of relief and additional personnel and equipment in order to keep up with the rising water.

DPW crews are also being asked to provide sandbagging for the three Acme Food Storage Warehouses located near the railroad terminals at 24<sup>th</sup> St and at 13<sup>th</sup> St. Can we provide this service?

We have two groups of volunteers here, one from the Handsboro Baptist Church on T & 20<sup>th</sup> St. and one from the First Christian Church on T & 16<sup>th</sup> St., and they are refusing to work together. Apparently there is a longstanding feud between these two churches over some land issues. Whatever the reason, we need someone to take care of this. We have to get this sandbagging done or the ER may be shut down. My two engine companies can't do it by themselves.

As you know, we have contracted with the county for years to do the majority of the paving work. We would like the opportunity to contract with Central City to provide our trucks, loaders, and drivers to haul sand and sandbags. As a reminder, many of our employees are residents and taxpayers in Central City and they deserve a chance to be gainfully employed rather than bringing in a bunch of out-of-town Guardsmen.

I will be talking to the mayor about this if we don't get a satisfactory answer.

My officers want to return to their homes in this area to check up on family. I may need some relief officers here to cover my area.

**Message # 19:**

We have floodwaters in our parking lot on the west side of the building. Currently the water is approximately 200 yards from the entrance to the ER.

We heard news reports that the bridge on Interstate I-5 is damaged and may collapse, causing a massive amount of water to go downstream very quickly. If this occurs our ER will be flooded. We are currently at 90% capacity in the ER and may have to evacuate if further flooding occurs. Many of our patients are complaining of gastrointestinal or flu-like symptoms.

The media have been calling to ask about a public service announcement on the radio telling people to boil water for purification for the next 48 hours. Do you have any information about this?

**Message # 20:**

The crane that was damaged by the wind is hopelessly entangled in the bridge superstructure and we are unable to move it. With the crane up against the bridge, debris coming downstream is piling up on the bridge, effectively damming the river. Floodwaters are now quickly rising above the bridge and will soon threaten the water treatment plant and more importantly will soon overflow the water intake at the plant.

State engineers have come up with a plan to dynamite the crane to remove it. The problem is the blast will probably weaken the bridge and if it goes we will be releasing a lot of water downstream. The excess water will exceed the floodplain indicated on the map and may threaten the two electric substations downriver, Faith Hospital at S & 14<sup>th</sup> Sts., three food warehouses, and several schools and shelters. The north/south bus route on S & T Streets will also be flooded and impassable.

Please advise on how you want us to proceed. With more debris coming downstream, time is of the essence here.

Is there any truth to the rumor that you are considering dynamiting the I-5 bridge? Releasing that much water will undoubtedly flood both of our substations downstream and take them both off-line. We are having a difficult time keeping up with the current demand given the power outages and downed lines across the county. Losing these two substations could cause a loss of power over much of the city. We are currently providing priority power to Faith Hospital, the water treatment plant and pump stations, and the Police and Fire Stations to keep these essential services operating. We may not be able to continue to provide power in the central part of the city if we lose those two substations.

Please let us know what your plans are.

I feel compelled to remind you that while we are supportive of the needs of the community, the crane is an expensive piece of private property and any attempt to destroy it would result in our seeking legal recourse for the loss of this equipment and for the resulting loss of income that the company will incur.

We need to explore a more reasonable approach to this problem. What do you plan to do about this situation?
